Short description: Old and New Churches, the majestic Town Hall of XVII century. Chapel of Saint Ippolit, the Delft's protector. Former bailey of the Saint Agata abbey, now - the Delft's historical museum. Walking around the fish market of XIII century, museum of famous Dutch painter, Johannes Vermeer, picturesque bridges and canals. If time will allow - age-old gate with the view on raising bridge on the canal with the numerous swimming birds.

16th century, Peace Palace, and many- many more...

Excursion to Rotterdam and Leiden

Meeting point: Hampshire Delft Hotel Centre

Transfer to Rotterdam: 9.00 – 9.30

City tour of Rotterdam: 9.30 – 13.00

Short description: The monument to the Peter the First, historical old harbor, age-old ships. The famous Kubuswoningen or cube houses built by architect Piet Blom in 1984, the first skyscraper of the Europe, the main church and the main monument of Rotterdam.



Free time in Rotterdam: 13.00 – 14.00

Transfer from Rotterdam to Leiden: 14.00 – 15.00

City tour of Leiden: 15.00 – 18.00

Short description: Spirit of the Golden Age, fatherland of the famous Rembrandt... Western architecture in the Late Medieval and Early Modern period in aggregate with the Renaissance and Baroque Italy. Alternative architecture of the 20th century, from regionalism and traditionalism to neo-baroque. The city of canals. The Rapenburg canal, according to Leiden patriots, - the most beautiful canal in the world.
