First informational letter

On October 8, 2011, we are celebrating the 100th anniversary of the Corresponding Member of the Academy of Sciences of the USSR Alexey Andreevich Lyapunov (1911–1973). He was the forefather of Russian cybernetics, the founder of the Moscow and Siberian research schools of cybernetics and theoretical programming, and one of the founders of the Novosibirsk State University and the Physicomathematical Secondary School associated with the University.

He was a person of unique significance in Russian cybernetics. In 1996, he was posthumously awarded the most honored prize of the global *Computer Society*, the *Computer Pioneer* medal as the developer of the operator programming method and founder of Soviet cybernetics and programming. The scope of Lyapunov's scientific interests covered numerous problems of modern mathematics, informatics, biology, Earth science, philosophy, and education.

In order to commemorate the outstanding Russian scientist and citizen, the Novosibirsk State University, Institute of Cytology and Genetics, Sobolev Institute of Mathematics, Institute of Computational Technologies, Institute of Computational Mathematics and Mathematical Geophysics, Ershov Institute of Informatics Systems, and Institute of Pedagogical Studies of Gifted Children hold the international conference dedicated to Alexey Lyapunov's centenary.
